About Each One, Teach One

Explore Himalaya Community Service Program has introduced Each One, Teach One project with a goal to provide education to conflict-affected children in a bid to give them a better chance to live a happy, secure and healthy life. The project is primarily focused on ensuring childrens' right to education. For this, EHCSPP seeks financial support from various donors who would be willing to sponsor for the education of disadvantaged, poor and needy children. With the funds collected from the donors, the project targets to provide monthly scholarship of Rs 1000 to conflict-affected children till high school graduation. The money received will be directly utilized for childrens' school fees, stationeries, outfits and other necessary educational resources.

Why this project?

Education is the only tool that can rehabilitate the conflict-affected children. Education instills in the children the crucial humanitarian values such as equity, tolerance and peace. With an access to education, children can attain a sense of freedom, purpose and responsibility, self-confidence and vision for the future. To be advantaged in terms of income, health and opportunity, academic education is a must. Undeniably, Education holds the key to childrens' empowerment. Each One, Teach One is aimed at empowering all those children who have been displaced, orphaned, forced into child labor and subjected to various atrocities during armed conflict. Education will be their powerful tool to combat their misfortunes and shape their future. Since children are the mirrors of future, empowered children in a long run will undoubtedly empower the whole community and then by default the entire nation.





Current Scenario in Nepal

Maoist 'People's war' has plundered Nepal with random killings, terror, threats, kidnappings, human rights violations and unease since 1996. Corruption, misuse of state authority and development malpractices ruled over Nepal for a decade sidelining the development practices. Like many other sectors, education system has been largely hampered specially in rural areas. Many were physically and mentally abused, maimed, wounded, physically disabled or psychologically tortured by both sides of the war. Children are the most vulnerable groups in Nepal who have been directly and indirectly impacted by the pernicious armed conflict. Official statistics show that more than 3000 children have been displaced, about 1500 orphaned and many traumatized alarmingly affecting their social, physical, mental and emotional development. Many became victims of child labor and war atrocities. With the fleeing of teachers, school shutdowns, childrens' involvement in the insurgency and displacement of families in the past, children have become deprived of their fundamental rights to education. The conflict has left thousands of children orphaned or helpless. Many bright children who have high potential of becoming a capable citizen with the power of education are today faced with uncertainties and unknown faith.





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How can you help?

Investing in children will be investing in the future. You have a power to make a difference in the lives of these poor souls. All you need to do is fund for the scholarship program for these conflict-affected children. Annually you need to contribute 200\$ for each children out of which 135\$ will directly go to the children. Local guardians will be authorized to mobilize this fund for children's education. We will send you children's regular progress report twice in a year to assure you that your contribution has indeed been very fruitful.
